Select your party preference. <i>You may vote in only ONE party section at a partisan primary.</i> -If you designate a party preference, votes cast in that party section will be counted. Votes cast in any other party section will not be counted. -If you do not designate a party preference, and you vote in more than one party section, no votes will be counted.</p> <p>2.)
